Your child will listen to and talk about the story *How Do Dinosaurs Go to School?*, a fantasy about how dinosaurs behave at school.

**Letter Hunt** Write the letters *Pp, Qq, Rr, Ss, and Tt* on slips of paper. Hold up the letters *Pp*. Ask your child to name the letters and then to look for capital *P* and lowercase *p* in books or magazines, on food labels, or on street signs and billboards. Start your child on a new letter hunt after several examples of *P* and *p* have been found.

**A School Visitor** Have your child imagine a story about a dinosaur coming to school. Together, think of funny things the dinosaur might say to different people, such as the teacher, the principal, the librarian, the crossing guard, and the school bus driver. For example, the dinosaur might say to the librarian: *The books in the library look very delicious!*

**All Mixed Up** On separate slips of paper, write the letters *l, i, k, e*. Mix up the letters. Ask your child to arrange the letters to spell the word *like*. Then ask him or her to say a sentence using the word. Mix up the letters a few more times, asking for a new sentence each time.

**CHALLENGE**

Your child can write a sentence beginning with the words *I like* and complete it with a picture or a word.
